Background

- 9. Law, Governance, Regional Integration, and International Relations
- 10. Education Research

ii Eligibility

- Open to teaching and research staff of Arba Minch University
- · Multidisciplinary teams are required
- Priority will be given to concept notes that:
 - o Are female-led
 - o Align with national and regional development goals
 - o Demonstrate potential for external funding or scalability

☐ Mandatory Team Composition

Each thematic research team must include:

- Experts from at least three distinct disciplines
- Three senior staff members, with one designated as Lead Principal Investigator (PI)
- · Two PhD students and one Master's student
- At least one female staff member
- · One junior staff member
- One professional from a relevant industry or sector office
- A clearly defined role and work package for each team member

Concept Note Format and Content

Concept notes serve as an initial screening tool for thematic relevance and feasibility. They must:

- Be maximum five pages, single-spaced, Times New Roman 12 pt font
- Follow APA referencing style
- Include the following sections:
 - 1. Project Title
 - 2. Introduction and Problem Statement
 - 3. Key Research Objectives (goal and specific objectives)
 - 4. Overview of Proposed Methodology
 - 5. Expected Outcomes and Impact
 - 6. Alignment with AMU's Thematic Areas
 - 7. Target Groups/Beneficiaries
 - 8. Project Duration and Timeline
 - 9. Budget Summary/Estimate
 - 10. PI and Co-Investigators with Specializations
 - 11. Contact Information
 - 12. References



Budget and Duration

• Maximum Budget: ETB 2-5 million per project

 Budget depends on thematic project type, project scope, lab/field intensity, and intervention components (See the guideline for details) and subject to budget defence

• Project Duration: 3 to 4 years

- Evaluation Criteria (see Annex 4 of the guideline):

 - o Societal Relevance (15%)
 - o Scientific Merit (15%)
 - o Impact Potential (15%)
 - o Partnership & Funding Viability (15%)
 - o MEL Compatibility (10%)
 - o Compliance with Required Components (15%)
